The Course is 1 kilometer long. Electrically timed (Loughborough-Hayes System.)

TWO CARS RUN TOGETHER.

A word as to the method of starting may be of interest to those who are unable to actually compete. Starting is carried out by means of lights similar to traffic lights, and the "hockey sticks" placed in front of the car wheels are merely false start detectors, which operate if the car moves forward before the green light shows. At the finish an "electric eye" is able to time to an accuracy of one hundredth of a second.
