1 Paddock Hill Bend

downhill corner which is unsighted for the drivers. GP cars 90 mph, Touring cars 80-85 mph.

2 Pilgrims' Rise GP cars 115 mph.

3 Druid's Bend open hairpin, very wide. Saloons 40 mph, GP 50 mph.

4 A deceptive corner at the foot of the hill. Saloons 70 mph, GP 90 mph.

5 Bottom Straight

Saloons 95 mph, GP 120 mph.

6 Long left hand bend under bridge with camber variations.
Saloons 70 mph, GP 90 mph.

7 Straight. Saloons 110 mph, GP 150 mph.

8 Hawthorn Bend fast bend with even radius. Saloons 90 mph, GP 110 mph.

9 Westfield Bend a sharp but fast bend. Saloons 75 mph, GP 110 mph.

10 Dingle Dell
a steep descent and climb into a sharp
tightening corner.
Saloons 65 mph, GP 75 mph.

11 Stirling's Bend tricky left-hander with little width for error. Saloons 50 mph, GP 70 mph.

12 The double bend at Clearways is approached by GP cars at 120 mph and taken at nearly 100 mph.

13 Top Straight
GP cars 135 mph, Touring cars 100 mph.

The Cinturato test day has been planned and directed in association with the panel of famous rally and racing drivers. Morning Session

The British School of Motoring Skid Pan will be open and you will be able to see demonstrations of skid

correction.

Afternoon session

5 Pirelli's own test drivers will demonstrate the roadholding and stability characteristics of Cinturato tyres with comparable tests on conventional tyres.

6 John Sprinzel, Ken Rudd and Peter Jopp will demonstrate the techniques of rally driving which brought them success. Ken Rudd and John Sprinzel will then demonstrate the differing techniques of racing using the ex-Mike Salmon Le Mans Aston Martin.

7 Some of the selected Cinturato users will drive around the Brands Hatch circuit whilst Ken Rudd, sitting in the commentator's box, will give a running commentary on the reactions of the drivers to the test demonstrations. Presentation of prizes to the 12 consumers.
