





**STP Grand Touring Car Championship**

The British branch of S.T.P., the American motor lubricant company which has been so successful in entering Indianapolis 500 Mile Race winners, is sponsoring the S.T.P. Grand Touring Car Championship of 1969. This is being contested over 20 club-type meetings and National meetings from May to December at Brands Hatch, Mallory Park, Oulton Park and Snetterton.

The S.T.P. Trophy Race at each of the selected meetings has four classes : Over 2500 cc, 1601 - 2500 cc, 1151 - 1600 cc and up to 1150 cc. Points are scored on the basis of four for the winner of each class, three for second place, two for third and one for fourth place in the class.

The overall winner will be the driver who is the highest points scorer, irrespective of class, counting his best scores in one class only in any 12 of the 20 qualifying rounds. He will receive £100 and the S.T.P. Trophy. The top scorer in each of the other three classes will receive £50.




