



Ever increasing popularity of BBC Radio 1 events

Today's seventh round of the BBC Radio 1 Production Saloon Car Championship has attracted maximum permissible entries—twenty cars plus four reserves—in each of the qualifying races.

As this popular championship progresses, so the number of drivers keen to enter increases and even today's massive entry list lacks a number of drivers who were competing in the last round at Silverstone last weekend.

Regular spectators at rounds of the Radio 1 championship will recognise new names in the entry lists for today's third and sixth events—among them Tony Lanfranchi, Bill Sydenham (with a new car) and Peter Jopp.

Lanfranchi and Sydenham have both joined the rotary club, not the national businessmen's organisation, but the Mazda RX3 brigade, bringing the number of these rotary engined cars in the championship up to a record ten. A very suitable sponsor has been found for Lanfranchi's car in the shape of DJM Records, the label on which Elton John records—an apt sponsor in the championship backed by Britain's leading pop music station. Sydenham, too, has a record label behind him, this time A & M Records the same company that sponsored the Hillman Avenger which he recently sold.

Both these drivers are making their first appreances in their Mazdas today and line up alongside such notaries as championship leader Jock Robertson, rock drummer Coxy Powell, Peter Slade, Wendy Harkey and Barry Andrews.

In the same race, another new car on the scene is the smart Mini 1275 GT of British Racing and Sports Car Club chairman Peter Jopp, who was seen in a Moskvich last year. His "cherished" number plate JOPIE has now found it's way onto this

ShellSPORT Escort Lords v Commons Race

Today's ShellSPORT Escort race sees the return of some of the most colourful figures in British politics to the country's busiest motor racing circuit in a team event in which Lords are matched against Commons.

Britain's own motor racing noblemen, Lord Alexander Hesketh, patron of the Hesketh Formula One team, heads the list of House of Lords members due to drive, which include Duke of Fife, ex-Formula 3 pilots the Earl of Denbigh and the Earl of Suffolk and Berkshire and others including Lord Strathcarron.

On the Commons side, colourful gourmet and MP Clement Freud is by far the most experienced with nine or ten races under his belt. He is a real trier in these races and could well be first past the chequered flag. The Commons team also includes Shadow Minister for Sport, Mr. Hector Monro and Geoffrey Johnson-Smith.

The wonderful prizes on offer for this ten lap race are described on page 8 of this programme.

baby British Leyland car which is backed for this series by the Evening Standard and Henlys.

Real BBC Radio 1 flavour is added to this championship by the participation of breakfast show disc jockey Noel Edmonds in a Castrol-backed 3-litre Ford Capri. "Super Noel" is here today—his first visit to Brands Hatch this year—hoping to beat off some of the remaining Capris in the hands of drivers such as Ivan Dutton, Phil Dowsett, Neil McGrath and under-21 stars Marc Smith, Mike Smith and Rod Birley. With maximum entries and some excellent racing promised in the BBC Radio 1 races today, it would be easy to forget the other events in this eight race programme, organised by the British Racing and Sports Car Club, but that would be a mistake. The BRSCC's two one-make saloon car formulae get an airing here today—the Penthouse Ford Escort Championship and the Renault 5 Elf Challenge. The last Escort race at Brands was a real cracker, with three cars in contention for the lead throughout the race... and today's promises to be just as good.

Ex-Formula 5000 star Steve Thompson has joined the Escort pilots, driving the Opposite Lock Club's Mexico, which was driven during the early part of the year by the club's patron Martin Hone.

Thompson has very little saloon car experience, most of his racing career having been spent in single-seaters, but in his first Mexico race at Mallory Park a few weeks ago he drove a well-planned race, taking victory with some demon overtaking on the last corner of the last lap.

First three rounds of the series were won by Mike Freeman who currently leads the championship by a fair margin but, as Thompson is to drive the Opposite Lock Club car for the rest of the season, Freeman may not have it all his own way.

The Renault 5s are making their first visit to Brands Hatch this year today with Sittingbourne driver Keith Collier—who made quite a name for himself with an amazing roll at the hairpin at Mallory Park last year—poised to take the lead in the Challenge.

Reigning champion and current championship leader is Neil McGrath and he will not be too ready to allow Collier to outdo him but, as Brands is definitely Collier's "home" circuit, he could well pull off a demon drive.

Two heats and a final towards the National Organs Formula Ford championship promise some very close racing, with maximum entries for the two heats—which means forty cars—and only twenty places on the grid for the final.

Front-runners in this series—lap record holder Rob Wicken, Kenny Gray, Geoff Lees and Phil Dowsett—are sure to make these races good value for spectators.


