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Flag Signals

Blue/Steady: Another competitor is close. Waved: Another competitor is trying to pass.

White: Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.

Yellow/Steady: Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down.

Yellow/Waved: Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down, be prepared to stop.

Yellow with Red Stripes: Slippery surface ahead.

Green: Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared.

Red: Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals.

Black (at individual marshal's posts): Race stopped.

Black/Orange Disc displayed with White number: Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver, call into pits immediately.

Black/White rectangular with White number: Warning to driver that his behaviour (i.e. corner cutting) is suspect and he may be black flagged.

Black displayed with White number: Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of the Course.

Black/White Chequered: End of race:

Races at all Brands Hatch Circuits are started using a system of red/green traffic lights.

Spectator Notices

Please do not leave litter about the grounds—take it with you.

Remember to drive with care and caution when leaving the grounds. To safeguard both competitors and public—animals are not admitted. This is most important.

Prohibited Area Notices: The public are not permitted in the areas where these notices are displayed. The fences are there for protection, and any person or persons found trespassing, or wilfully damaging trees, fences, etc., will be prosecuted by Brands Hatch Circuits Limited.

BRSCC Championship Car Races, Brands Hatch, 31st May

What, no Formula Fords! Yes, today's hectic nine race championship programme features a splendid variety of what is best in British club championship racing, but of the 200+ entries gathered for this BRSCC Raceday not one is a Formula Ford 1600.

Exceptional though it may be not to have any FF1600 action, this should be more than compensated for by two events for the innovative Formula First, the brainchild of BHL Managing Director, John Webb. An excellent entry of over forty cars has been assembled for the Cellnet-sponsored championship race. Such is the size of the entry that two practice sessions are required, with the slower contingent in a qualification event for places in the championship race.

In Kelvin Burt and Raphael Real Del Sarte, the Team Touraco International Racing Drivers School, based at Cadwell Park, have two leading contenders but the current points standings are led by Eugene O'Brien and Brands Hatch Racing's own instructor, Ben Edwards. Watch also for Ian Johnson who this year has switched tacks after winning the BRSCC's Alfa Romeo Championship in 1986.

The afternoon kicks off with a race for the smaller engined cars in the Shell Oils Super Road Saloon Championship. The BRSCC was instrumental in bringing roadgoing saloon cars to the circuits, enabling many people to race for the first time on limited budgets. Such was the success of the concept that two championships were devised for 'Budget' (virtually unmodified) cars and the 'Super' classes for competitors who have uprated their cars with certain modifications although remaining road legal. With the welcome support of Shell Oils, there is no shortage of takers for the series, as witnessed by the large entry, necessitating two races here today. Andy McLaughlan's Fiesta is likely winner of Race 1, the current points leader in Class B comfortably clear of Mike Marlowe in his Talbot Sunbeam. Gordon Luxford (Fiesta) and Simon Tate (Escort) are not far behind, however. In the 1300cc class, Steve Jarvis (Honda) is clear leader, having won his class on the three previous races so far this year.

In the larger capacity classes, consistency has brought Ray West (Opel Manta) to the head of the Class C table, eight points clear of joint second-placemen, Robert Beaumont and John Woodward. However, it is in Class D for the 2300cc-4000cc machinery that we find the overall highest points scorer, Derek Wileman in his 3-litre Capri. In hot pursuit are more Capris, piloted by Angus Mackay and Andrew Mackenzie, closely followed by the spectacular Rover of Francis Butcher. Road Saloon racing really does provide an excellent variety for the spectator with over twenty different makes and models on the track here today.

Further variety is added to the schedule with a round of the increasingly popular, Caterham Cars/BRSCC Roadgoing 7 Series. Last year's champion, Kelvin Foy is having to work hard to retain his title, the Class A race currently being led by Jeremy Coulter, who at the time of going to press had not entered. Jim McDougall, Reg Price and Jez Coates have all featured strongly at various races so far this year, so none can be discounted from overall honours. In Class B, Wally Liles and George Cubitt are on level pegging so the action here is sure to be frenetic.

The Renault 5TS Championship has long been a mainstay of BRSCC meetings, and over the years its fortunes have fluctuated considerably. Earlier this year at Brands, a splendid battle was enacted and now on their second visit to the Kent circuit, the race has attracted the biggest entry for quite some time and also boasts a new sponsor. In a deal that was concluded very rapidly less than a month ago, Mita Copystar (UK) Ltd have confirmed their support of the series for the rest of the year, using the title Mita Copiers, with an increase in prize money. This form of racing really does remain one of the most cost effective on the national scene and is fought out by very enthusiastic drivers loyal to the marque. Picking a winner? Just about anyone from the entry list, but keep an eye out for Marc Donaldson, Steve Meloy, Ray Ledwith, Richard Bateman, Martin Hood etc, etc.

There is certainly an Italian flavour to the programme for as has become commonplace, so many Alfa Romeos want to play that two races are required, and further variety is added with the inclusion of the Italian Car Challenge, where Alfas confront assorted Lancias, Fiats and from time to time a Ferrari or two has appeared. The biggest single class of Alfa Romeos contest Race 9 for production models up to 1600cc. Heading the entry list is Roger Veall, who is also heading the class points table. Keith Notley, Tim Daniells and Frank Manning are all well to the fore in various 'Suds, while also in a 'Sud is the only lady in the race, No. 8 Janet Sherry.

From the other Championship race we find the overall Alfa leader, Bob Buttery, who has scored three outright Class B wins this year from four races so far. Both Bob and second placeman Clive Hodgkin are driving GTV6s. All the other leading runners from the modified classes are entered, so a keen battle for honours can be expected between Messrs Stewart, Giordanelli and Sweetapple in D, Nick Sismey and Mike Buckler in C, and Colins, Roberts and Burnes, from Class E.

We hope you have an enjoyable day's racing, whether viewing or competing and look forward to seeing you again at Brands in two weeks' time for the next BRSCC Race Meeting.

Shell Oils Super Road Saloon Championship

The BRSCC Super Road Saloon concept continued to expand in 1986 and this year, the series has retained the support of Shell Oils to back the 10race championship. In virtually all cases, two races per meeting will be run. The series is run in four classes: Up to 1300cc; 1301-1800cc; 1801-2300cc; 2300-4000cc.

Points system: In each class, 10 points for each

classified finisher. One point for every car beaten (every car leaving the grid under its own power will be deemed to have started) and one point for fastest

Awards: Trophies for each class winner. £15 per finish to be paid at the end of the season. End of season awards: For each class winner, a trophy and £100; 2nd and 3rd in each class, a trophy.





ALFA ROMEO CHAMPIONSHIP

The 1987 BRSCC Alfa Romeo Championship is open to drivers of any Alfa Romeo and will be run on a sealed handicap basis and is sponsored by Alfa Romeo (UK) Ltd. 



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
