

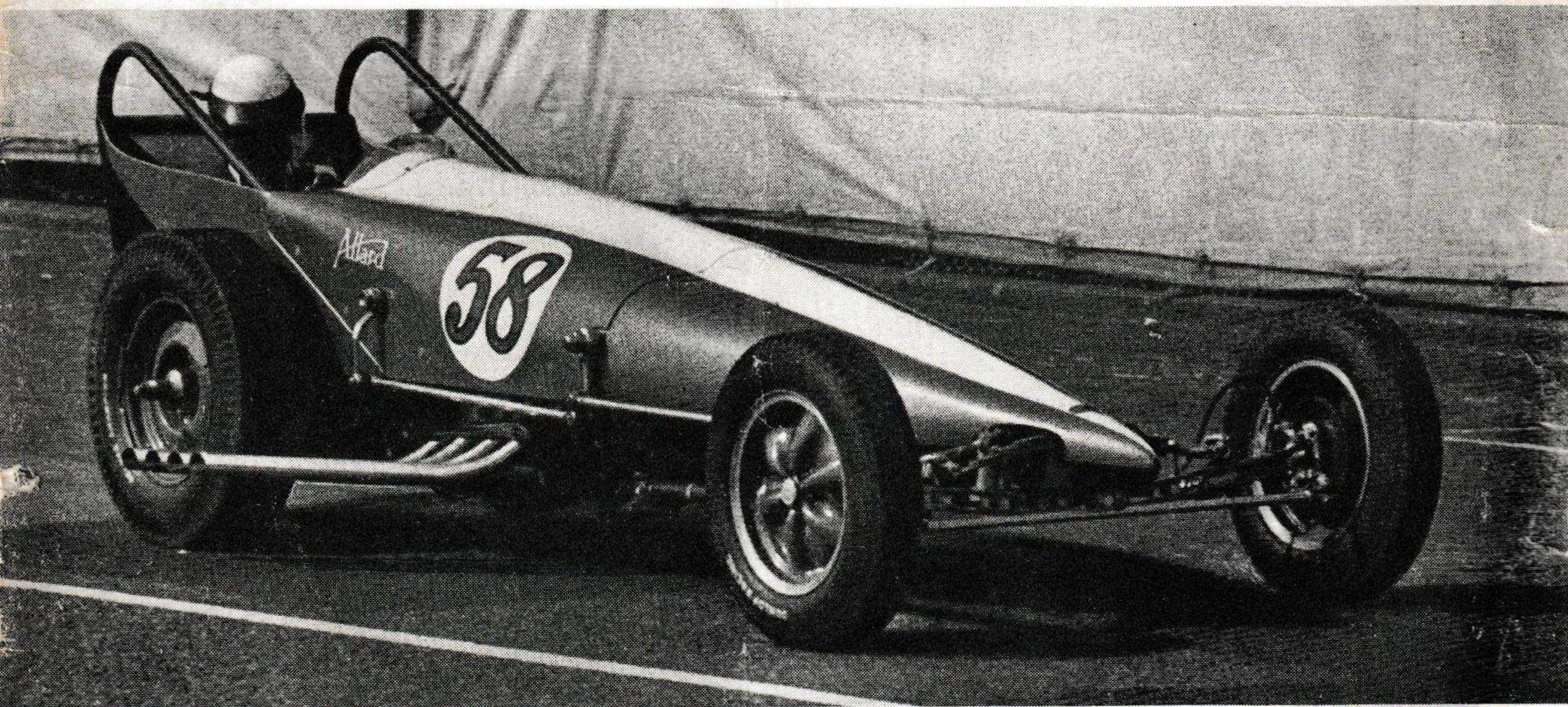

In recent years the event has been held at North Weald, but due to circumstances beyond our control this venue is no longer available to us. However, thanks to the co-operation we have received from the authorities here we hope you will all enjoy the facilities which have so kindly been made available to us. As is always the case, to-day's programme includes the names of the majority of the expert drivers in this branch of motor sport. We are also pleased to announce that this is the first qualifying meeting for the recently presented Autosport National Sprint Trophy. Amongst the most exciting machinery due to appear to-day are Sydney Allard's Dragster and Tony Marsh's B.R.M. Sprint Special. Timing equipment is being operated which can record speeds up to 100th of a second, and it is anticipated that some very rapid motoring is going to take place. We hope both competitors and spectators have an enjoyable day.

AUTOSPORT NATIONAL SPRINT TROPHY FOR CARS OF UNLIMITED CAPACITY
AWARDED FOR BEST FOUR PERFORMANCES IN SELECTED STANDING START,
STRAIGHT LINE SPRINT EVENTS

The West Essex Speed Trials constitute the first event eligible for this Trophy, which has been presented by Autosport, and is under the auspices of the National Sprint Association. The positions are to be determined regardless of class, and points allocated as follows

F.T.D. : 9 points	3rd : 4 points	5th : 2 points
2nd : 6 points	4th : 3 points	6th : 1 point

Its object is to encourage standing start, straight line sprinting, and future qualifying events will be over 440 yards, 880 yards and 1 kilometre distances. The number of eligible events is not limited, but the driver's four best performances will determine his position.

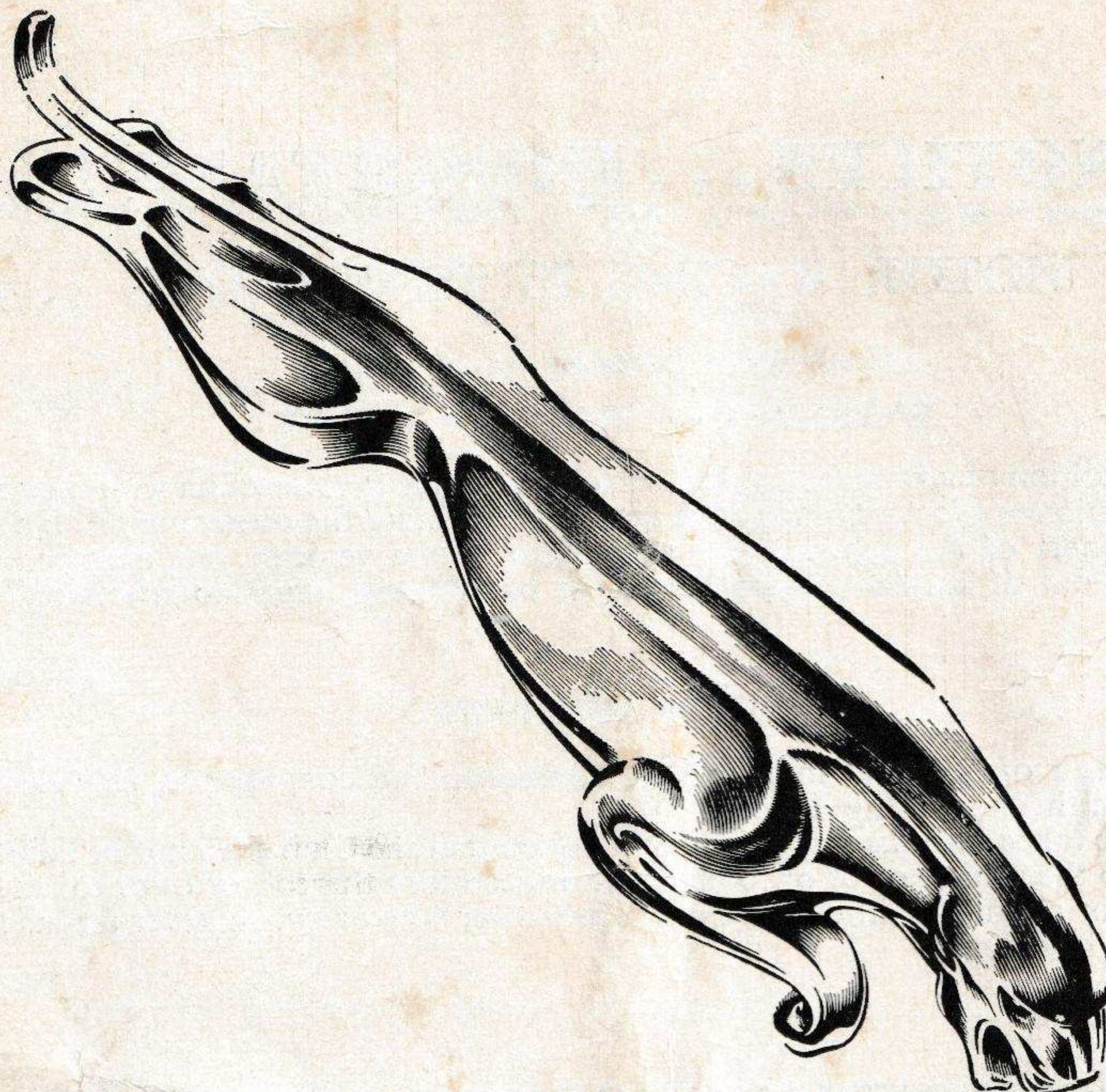
