## RELIANT 750 FORMULA CHAMPIONSHIP

Once again a record breaking year for this ever popular low cost form of motor racing. Over 90 competitors have registered to take part in the 23 race series. The Reliant Motor Company, the largest independent British motor manufacterer have supported the championship for the past 9 years.
The cars are mainly home built sports cars powered by the all aluminium Reliant 750 cc engine. Limited tuning is allowed but chassis design is restricted in order to keep costs to a minimum.
