



RELIANT 750 FORMULA CHAMPIONSHIP

Once again a record breaking year for this ever popular low cost form of motor racing. Over 90 competitors have registered to take part in the 23 race series. The Reliant Motor Company, the largest independent British motor manufacturer, have supported the championship for the past 9 years.

The cars are mainly home built sports cars powered by the all aluminium Reliant 750cc engine. Limited tuning is allowed but chassis design is restricted in order to keep costs to a minimum.

Points are scored on a 10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3 basis with 2 for every other finisher and 1 for all starters. The best 8 scores count but ties are decided by taking into

account the next best scores.

Today's race for Leyland Mini 850 saloons (formerly Mini-Seven) is an integral part of the 1977 Leyland Cars Mini Challenge, which is also contested by Mini 1000 and 1275 GT cars. The Championship is sponsored by Leyland Cars and administered for them by the Mini 7 Racing Club.

In each category, points are allocated in every race as follows: -

10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3 to the first eight finishers. All other finishers receive two points and non-finishers one point.

For the Mini 850 category, there are awards in each race consisting of: 1st, £15 voucher for Leyland ST parts; 2nd, £10 voucher; 3rd £5 voucher; 4th, £2 voucher; together with trophies for each of the first four. End of season awards are £85 and the Bob Fox Trophy and replica for the winner and £75 -£70 - £65 - £60 - £55 - £50 - £45 - £40 - £35 plus trophies for second to 10th place holders.

In addition, competitors in all three categories are eligible for the national championship awards of: 1st - Leyland Mini 1275 GT car; 2nd - Leyland ST parts voucher to the value of £500; 3rd - vouchers to the value of £250.

ATLAS PHOTOGRAPHY FORMULA 1300 CHAMPIONSHIP

It is proving a fantastic year for this 24 race series for two seater sports racing cars. Over 70 drivers have already registered and will be taking advantage of the bonuses to be paid by the new sponsors, ATLAS PHOTOGRAPHY. ATLAS PHOTOGRAPHY, who handle all aspects of photography and photographic reproduction, have been in business for almost 30 years with a current staff of 43 in their London head office and another 12 in their branch at Coventry. Although trading and operating independently, they are part of a large group of companies, trading as the Edman Group, covering most aspects of advertising and communications, including exhibition and display contractors, two advertising agencies, a direct mail house in Feltham and another in Birmingham; two large printing houses, one in Feltham and one in Loughborough; two recruitment and search agencies, a silk screening house, and other peripheral companies all in the similar field. At present they have a combined staff of over 600 and are looking to break £8m sales turnover in the current financial year.

The cars are sports racing cars powered by a limited tune Ford push rod engine of up to 1300cc. Chassis design is free - cars may be either front or rear engined. Points in the series are scored on a 10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3 basis with 2 for every other finisher and 1 for all other starters. The best 8 scores only count and ties are decided by taking into account the 9th or 10th scores.

A M H E C FORMULA 4 CHAMPIONSHIP




