Clerk of the Course Yellow with red stripes: Oil flag. Displayed when oi has been dropped on the circuit in that section, displayed until the hazard has been dealt with. Also enotes slippery surface ahead.
White: Ambulance or course car on circuit. Yellow with black cross: Denotes start of last lap. Black/white chequered: Denotes finish of race, usually waved at the winner and held motionless until every other rider has passed.
$N B$ : Races at all $M C D$ system of red and green lights.
