





The sound and fury of fine old cars Historical racers come to Snetterton for the Scott-Brown Memorial Trophy

That Formula Atlantic record should go

The splendid sounds of old racing cars, an exciting melange of throaty roars and the high-pitched whine of superchargers, will echo round the circuit this afternoon in the Archie Scott-Brown Memorial Trophy Race, from which today's meeting takes its title.

It commemorates that great driver who was killed at Spa in 1958 and for whom Snetterton was his home circuit and the scene of his first exploits.

This 8-lap race is the third qualifying round of the JCB Championship for historic cars, sponsored by the Staffordshire-based manufacturers of excavators and construction equipment, and a tight points situation in all three classes has ensured a large top-class entry of find old machinery, much of which will be seen here for the first time.

Those two great historic car exponents, Neil Corner and the Hon. Patrick Lindsay are expected to continue their rivalry today. Lindsay, who in earlier rounds has driven an ERA and a Maserati 250F, has entered his very interesting Multi-Union for today's round.

This was originally a 1936 Tipo B Alfa Romeo, but was extensively modified by Chris Staniland. Its 3-litre 8-cylinder power unit has twin superchargers, and its special body — totally unlike the original — makes it look very much like a racing Mercedes.

Just before war broke out the Multi-Union made an attach on the Brooklands outright lap record, and despite piston trouble nearly made it.


Neil Corner is expecting to drive his really beautifully prepared Aston Martin DBR4 with which he has already had considerable success. This car was originally a 2½-litre GP machine, but was later fitted with a 3-litre engine for racing in Australia.

Another enthusiastic driver of historic cars is Colin Crabbe, who will be looking for points in the up-to-2-litre sports car class with his beautiful Ferrari Testa Rossa, while Nick Portaway is down to drive a 'C' Type Jaguar which used to be handled with such elan and distinction by Archie Scott-Brown.

The entry list makes fascinating reading, and includes several cars with exciting histories. The Maserati Tipo 61 which Brian Joscelyne is down to drive is one of the famous 'Birdcage' models, while the Aston Martin DB3S for Nigel Clarkson is the machine which Ken Wharton once drove. There are several 'D' Type Jaguars in the list, including the one to be driven by Mike Franey, which used to belong to Le Mans winners Ecurie Ecosse and sports an independant rear end.


The Rover Special was produced through the enthusiasm of Spenser King, and has a De Dion rear suspension which can probably be claimed to be the prototype of the Rovers on the roads today. The Alvis 4.3 entered by B.H. Clinkard is specially built up of pre-war parts and is said to be extremely quick in a straight line, though with a very wide variety of marques represented, including AC, Lotus, Lister, Maserati, Aston Martin, Jaguar, Alvis, Rover and Cooper, this promises to be a race for all Snetterton enthusiasts to remember.

Today also sees the return to the circuit of the very rapid Formula Atlantic cars, which are currently the second quickest single-seaters round here.

The 15-lap Yellow Pages Formula Atlantic Race brings together all the leading contenders in the £5,000 Yellow Pages Formula Atlantic Championship. Current points leader Vern Schuppan, who has been using a BRM-prepared Twin Cam in his Palliser WDB4, is hoping to have it replaced with a BDA power unit for today's race, and this should make him even quicker.

The last time Formula Atlantic racing was seen here was on June 27, when Peter Wardle, in his Lotus 69 (entered as the ART Rowland), set a new lap record of 1 minute 31.0s, a speed of 107.21 miles an hour. That day he was very narrowly beaten in an exciting finish by the Danish star, Tom Belso, in his Brabham BT28, and since then Tom has been putting up some impressive lap times during private practice: he has been timed at 1 minute 29.6 seconds, and several drivers feel that 1 minute 29.0 seconds is on the cards — which would mean a lap speed knocking on 110 miles an hour.

With Cyd Williams expected to turn out in Graham Eden's Chevron B18C, there is every prospect of an exciting battle.

Clubman's Formula sports cars will also be out in force for today's round of the Shell-Gregor Grant Clubman's Formula Championship, in which Brian Husbands (U2 Mk8B), Sid Marler (Ellova Mk2) and Noel Stanbury (Gryphon) are expected to be having close battle in the up-to-1,000 cc class, while Ray Mallock should definitely be the man to beat in his all-conquering U2 Mk11 in the 1,001-1,600 cc class.

With a busy programme that also includes races for saloons, Formula 4/ Formula Ford, Mini Seven/Miglia Mini Formulae, and Formule Libre, this should be a meeting full of excitement and variety.

Historic Car Championship

Today sees the third round of this brand new Championship, which has already proved to be a winner, both with spectators and drivers. The idea came from Speed Merchants, a specialist motoring agency run by Nigel Moores and Bill Allen, and Sponsorship was obtained through Anthony Bamford, Director of JCB, the Staffordshire based manufacturers of excavators and construction equipment. For some time, there have been races for 'historic' racing cars (basically front engined single seaters built before 1961) and also races for 'historic' sports cars from roughly the same era. But in both cases, there was usually insufficient cars to fill the grid for every race. Speed Merchants with JCB decided to run the two types together taking the best cars from each group, so as to make up a full grid of first class cars. The first round was a resounding success, the front row of the grid comprising two single seaters and two sports racers, while in practice, the 12 places from 7th to 18th comprised six single seaters and six sports racers and all within 1.2 seconds of each other.

The JCB Championship rules ensure that the winner can come from any of the three classes, so keen rivalry extends throughout the field.






