

IMPORTANT

Wigram is the operational airfield and the Motor Racing Club has obtained the use of it for this motor race meeting only by courtesy of the R.N.Z.A.F. After this meeting the airfield must be cleared of all litter, some of which, such as broken glass, could make flying hazardous. The Motor Racing Club asks for your co-operation in keeping the airfield and its precincts as tidy as possible. The Air Force have also specifically requested that the base be cleared of patrons as soon as possible after the conclusion of the racing. Patrons are requested therefore to leave the grounds immediately the racing ceases and **must not remain on the grounds for any purpose later than two hours after the conclusion of the last race.**

Areas of the R.N.Z.A.F. base around the hangars and base buildings and in the vicinity of the Bomb Bays are out of bounds to patrons. No spectators may enter these areas except to use the walk way behind the hangars to move from one portion of the circuit viewing area to another. Only persons who are holders of the required badges are permitted on the inside of the circuit or in the pits. Any persons found in these areas without the required badge will be removed. Spectators must not cross the circuit.

The Motor Racing Club indemnifies the Royal New Zealand Air Force against any claims for injury or damages sustained as a direct result of the attendance of persons at the race meeting or on practice day and likewise should any persons be injured in the designated out of bounds areas the Royal New Zealand Air Force accepts no responsibility.


